# Opening Remarks of Baba Mwalimu K-Q Amsata, Coordinator of PAFM) - North America (Thursday, October 15, 2020 @ 8pm)

- Asante Sana tour Convention's Co MC, Brother Sam Collins for that generous Introduction. Brother Sam is a dynamic up and coming young Brother and you will be hearing form him again in his capacity as the Coordinator of the LCC in Washington DC;
- And thank you to our primary MC Dr. Uwa Onyioia Osimiri who I have had the
  pleasure of meeting several times in Atlanta and being a guest on her Radio Show;
- Asante Sana to our Secretary-General of the PAFM-North America, Mama Nobantu Ankoanda, for her wisdom and skills in overseeing all of the details, behind the scenes in organizing this Convention; and
- Finally thank you to all of you who have registered for this Convention and will be working with us, over the next five days, as we move "Forward Ever" towards n our Pan African Federalist Mission "To bring the United African States into Political Existence, NOW!"

#### WELCOME TO THE <u>NORTH AMERICAN</u> <u>PAN AFRICAN</u> FEDERALIST CONVENTION!

• TODAY, WE stand on the shoulders of the first duly elected Provisional President of Africa, the Right Excellent Marcus Garvey, who in 1924 wrote a prophetic poem "Hail! The United States of Africa", challenged us to bring into bring into political existence a Global African Nation "on which the Sun shall never set" and who, 100 years ago, in 1920, through his organization, convened the First Global Convention of African People of the World that brought together 25,000 delegates from 40 counties for the entire month of August 1920 and adopted a Universal Bill of Right for African People, created the Pan African Red, Black & Green Flag and loudly proclaimed "AFRICA for the AFRICANS, those at HOME and those ABROAD";

- WE stand on the shoulders of Dr. Kwame Nkrumah who on March 6, 1957, with less 5 minutes of Independence under his belt, proclaimed "The Independence of Ghana is meaningless, unless it is linked to the Total Independence of the African Continent" and 21 months later, in December 1958, at the All African People Conference, when Ghana and Guinee were the only 2 independent countries in Sub-Saharan, said: "This is the decade of Independence. Onward then to Independence. Independence Now! Tomorrow the United States of Africa". History records that five (5) years after that, in May of 1963, under Nkrumah's leadership 32 flag independent African States came together in Ethiopia to create the Organization of African Unity (OAU);
- WE stand on the shoulders of Omowale Malcolm X who attend the 2<sup>nd</sup> Summit
  of the OAU in July 1964 and speaking on behalf of African people in North America
  said "AFRICAM PROBLEMS are OUR PROBLEMS and OUR PROBLEMS are AFRICAN
  PROBLEMS"
- WE stand on the shoulders of Dr. Cheikh Anta Diop who said "The only State that is viable is the Federal State"
- WE stand on the shoulders of our esteemed African Elder Statesman, now African Ancestor, Mwalimu Julius Nyerere, in 1997, on the occasion of the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Ghana's independence challenge our generation to "pick up the mantle of African Unity that was dropped by his generation because "Without Unity, there is no Future for Africa"
- But only that....WE stand on the shoulders of Winnie Mandela who said "It is only when All Black Groups, join hands and speak with One Voice, that we shall be a bargaining force which will decide its own destiny"
- And WE stand on the shoulders of Miriam Makeba who called on us to come together in pan African Unity, fully assumed her acclaimed title as "Mama Africa" and was invited to perform at the inauguration of the OAU in 1963;
- And WE stand on the shoulders Queen Mother Moore, born in Louisiana but spent most her adult live in my hometown New York City, who called on Black people in North America to recognize and fully embrace the fact that "We are an African people" by saying "If a cat had kittens in oven they wouldn't be biscuits!"
- And finally WE stand on the shoulders of millions of other unnamed illustrious African Ancestors dating back 6000 years to the days of Imhotep in Ancient Kemet, when Africa stood as a World Power, before our recent nadir of the past 500 years.

- WE in the Pan African Federalist Movement (PAFM) seeks the reemergence of Africa as a <u>Self-reliant</u> and fully <u>Sovereign World Power</u>.
- Hence, our <u>exclusive and sole</u> Mission "To bring the United African States into political existence, Now!
- The PAFM started with a "CALL" coming out of West Africa (Senegal), in February 2015, to see if there was a critical mass of African people in the World who were disenchanted enough with our current condition to want join a Movement whose focused solely on the birth of the United African States.
- Three (3) months later, in May of 2015, Regional Initiating Committee of North America (for the US and Canada) was founded and I selected as its Coordinator.
- There are currently nine (9) active Regional Coordinating Committees throughout the World in the major locations where African people live, i.e., West Africa, East Africa, Southern Africa, Central Africa, the Caribbean, Latin America, North Africa, Europe and us right here in North America.
- The focus of the RCC-North America is the 47.8 Million people of African ancestry living in the United States and the 1.2 Million living in Canada. Taken as a whole if African people in North America were a sovereign State we would be the 8<sup>th</sup> most populous African State in the world and with a buying power of 1.2 trillion dollars we would be the richest African nation on Earth.
- The goal of the RCC-North America is to mobilize the African population in North America in support of a Global Federation of African States that will consist of more than **1.33 Billion African people worldwide.**
- This will enable the Global African Nation to become the masters of our own destiny and empower us to fully manage our own affairs (Sovereignty) and deal with the global powers that be from a position of strength.
- We have a **50 States and 10 Provinces** in Canada mobilization plan that focuses on the **67 cites** in North America that have the largest presence of African people.
- In December of 2018, I led the North America delegation to the Pan African Federalist Pre-Congress in Accra Ghana. Mama Nobantu was that delegation as were many others.
- The FINAL DECLARATION of this gathering was "a solemn call for all African People, wherever they may be in the world, to join in the active preparation for a Global Congress for the Poetical Unity of Africans.."

- And it is toward that end that we are gathered here today.
- The other eight Regions, previously mentioned will be holding comparable events in preparation for the Global Congress.
- The Theme of our North American Pan African Federalist Convention is "African Political Unity for Sovereignty and Upliftmanet" and over the next few days we will be dealing with three (3) Key Questions:
- 1. What does the campaign for the United Africa States (UAS) need from African people in North America?
- 2. What shall be the Expectation of African people in North America from the United States of Africa?
- 3. How will the rights of African people in North America figure into the Constitution of the United African States?
- These three questions will be addressed, deliberated upon and answered by YOU in specific Workshops designed for that purpose over the next three days.
- But before I go any further I would like you hear directly some of the leaders in the Pan African Federalist Movement (PAFM) at Home [in Africa] and Abroad [Us here in North America].
- I first met Brother Adama Samasseku at the aforementioned PAFM Pre Congress in Accra, Ghana in December 2018. He was insisting that I release one of the few copies of my book "The New Pan Africanism 2020" to him. I acquiesced. I'm glad I did.
- I later learned that Brother Adama was part of the IPIC that initiated the PAFM back in 2015. His leadership is outstanding so much so that he has been elected as the Chairman of the International Preparatory Committee (IPC) that oversees the activities of the PAFM throughout the world. Ladies and Gentlemen, Sisters and Brothers my Fellow Pan African Federalist, I have the <a href="high honor and distinct privilege">high honor and distinct privilege</a> of introducing our Global Leader Brother Adama....
- Now that we have heard from our Global Leader and I would like to acknowledge
  the presence of his Vice-Chair, my dear friend and brother with whom I have
  worked closely over the past five years, Brother Amadou Seek

- I would also like to acknowledge the presence of my dear friend and Brother Joomaay Faye whose is also one of the original founders of the PAFM in 2015 and currently serving as the Secretary-General of the IPC
- We are now going to hear from some key people who are in leadership positions in the PAFM-North America. They each will tell you a little about themselves and the activities of the PAFM in their respective areas.
- First up is Brother Kojo Kwadou Mendah who is the Coordinator for the National Coordinating Committee of Canada and was responsible for most of the publicity for this Convention. If you saw those beautiful flyers or heard the promos that was him. Sisters and Brothers – Brother Kojo...
- Brother Jiwe Dillard is the State Coordinator for New York State and is doing
  a great job in putting together a PAFM structure in New York City and Upstate New
  York Brother Jiwe...
- And no a dynamic young brother who you have heard from. He is one of the MC for this Convention and he introduced me. He has put together a fantastic Youth Forum for the Convention on Sunday night. But at this time Brother Sam Collins he will be speaking in his capacity a Coordinator of the LCC for Washington DC....
- Mama Nobantu was with my in Ghana for the Pre-Congress in December 2018. She is currently the Secretary- General. For the PAFM –North America. But before that she had built and still serves as the Coordinator of the strong viable LCC for Metro-Atlanta. Our original plans, before the advent of COVID 19, was to hold this Convention in Atlanta. Mama Nobantu has built a strong ground team who have taken on the responsibly of making this virtual Convention a success. Ladies and Gentlemen, my dear friend and Sister, Mama Nobantu/Atlanta...
- Dr. D. Ayoka Jasey Sowa-La was also in Ghana in December 2018. She serves
  as the Dep SG for PAFM NorAm but has recently been appointed as the new State
  Coordinator for Florida. We are looking forward to establishing strong viable LICs
  in Jacksonville, St. Augustine, Daytona, Orlando, Tampa and Miami and the person
  who is going to make it happen I my dear friend and Sister Ayoka.
- Brother Senghor Baye is our Chief Field Organizer and as such he is the primary person responsible for building a bottoms-up on the ground mass movement of African people in North America and implementing our 50 State/10 Canadian Province strategy and establish LCC in our 67 target city. It a big job but he is up to it. When I first met him in 2014, before the PAFM came into existence, Brother Senghor was serving as the 9<sup>th</sup> Successor to Marcus Garvey as President General of the UNIA-ACL. Baba Senghor the floor is yours....

- Finally, we will have Closing Remarks from my Deputy Coordinator, PAFM-North America Brother Cliff Kuumba after which he will be turning the Program back to the Convention MC, Dr. Uwa. You will be seeing Brother Cliff around this Convention as he gathers information for our Comprehensive Outcome Summary on Monday.
- Asante Sana/Thank you very much very being here and for the time you will be spending with us over the next few days as we ponder and answer key questions regarding the <u>destiny</u> of African People in North America. I will bid you farewell for a while, ever mindful that e "AFRICA MUST UNITE, NOW"! ...and on that note, here's Brother Cliff....

- The Mission of the PAFM is "To Bring the United African States into political exist now". ARE WE Closer to the goal then we were before this Convention?
- The theme of this Convention was "African Political Unification for Sovereignty and Upliftement" and in this regard....
- This Convention was assigned to discuss, deliberate on begin to answer three questions
- What does the Campaign for United African States (UAS) need from African people in North America? Have we made significant headway in answering that question?
- What shall be the expectations of African people in North America from the UAS? Have we made significant headway in answering that question?
- How will the rights of African people in North America figure into the Constitution of the United African States? Have we made significant headway in answering that question?

  for the Global Pan African Federalist Congress at the end of that year or
  hopefully by 2023 at the latest. This will be dependent on the progress that
  has been made, on the ground, by us in North America and the other PAFM
  Regions across the African World.
- It is the official position of the IPC of the PAFM that our goal to bring the birth of the UAS before this decade end in 2030. Personally, I would like to see the United African States to come into political existence by January 1 2025 to coincide with the end of the United Nations proclaimed International Decade for People of African Descent on December 31, 2024. Twenty-five years ago in 1995, I submitted a paper to the Pan African Conference at Temple University that scheduled the United African States to come into political existence in August of this year 2020. So from that perspective we are already two months behind schedule and counting....

- Once the United African States comes into political existence it <u>signal the</u> re-emergence of Africa as World Power capable of mastering its own affairs, managing the vast resources on the African Continent in the interest of African People as a whole and speaking to the Global World Powers that be from a position of Strength with a single President that has been elected by the 1.3 Billion African People .... The will African Global Umoja (Unity) and Global Kujichagulia (Self-Determination).
- This will be Global Game Changer for African People as a whole and every single African on Earth as an individual.
- I look forward to that glorious day when I am in Africa, with many of you, to witness the first President of the United African States raise her hand to take the Oath of Office.
- So let us leave this Convention fully committed to go back to our communities and organza, mobilize and galvanize to make this happen in short order.
- Our action in this regard will be in keeping with our PAFM Mission which is
